[Colin M. Fisher](#), Ph.D. is a professor, author, speaker, and occasional jazz trumpet player. He is the author of the new go-to book on group dynamics, [The Collective Edge: Unlocking the Secret Power of Groups](#), which has been translated into ten languages.

His [academic research](#) on group dynamics, creativity, improvisation, and leadership has been published in the field's top academic journals. His work has been featured in major media outlets, such as [BBC](#), *Financial Times*, [Forbes](#), *Fortune*, [Harvard Business Review](#), *MSN*, [NPR](#), *Psychology Today*, and [The Times](#). He is also a sought-after keynote speaker for businesses, governments, and non-profit organizations around the world seeking to improve teamwork, creativity, and decision-making. Colin is an associate professor and Ph.D. Programme Director at [University College London's School of Management](#). He received his Ph.D. in Organizational Behavior from Harvard University.
